2023 Ilbesheim Gewürztraminer Spätlese

Gewürztraminer, also known as Roter Traminer or Gelber Traminer, is a white wine variety with yellow-reddish berries. In the Baden growing region, the name Klevner or Clevner is also permitted. In general, different varieties are distinguished depending on the color of the berries (red berries: Roter Traminer, light red/yellow-pink: Gewürztraminer, yellowish: Gelber Traminer), but all of them may be called Gewürztraminer. In Alsace, the grape variety is called Gewurztraminer or Gewur(t)z for short. The name comes from Tramin in South Tyrol, where wines have been documented under this name since the 11th century. In Germany, the cultivation of the grape variety is recorded around the year 1500 in a mixed set (e.g. with Riesling). Gewürztraminer produces very aromatic wines with a fragrance reminiscent of rose petals and lychee.

WINE	Intense nose with tropical-exotic aromas of lychee, nutmeg and orange, enriched by the typical scent of rose petals.
VINTAGE	Hand-picked from a selective, very old vineyard
STORABILITY	10 years and more
FOOD RECOMMENDATION	With cold starters such as dried ham, terrines and fine pâtés. As a partner to cheese with blue cheese, Reblochon or Munster and in dessert with marzipan, chocolate mousse or creamy desserts with caramel and vanilla.
DRINKING TEMPERATURE	10 °C
ANALYSIS	Alc 11,0 %vol, Acidity 5,7 g/l, Residual Sugar 30,0 g/l
